Category	Description
1. Sunbiz Registration	Concept or business is registered with Sunbiz.
2. Levy County	Is the location of the proposed or established business in Levy County?
3. Chamber Partner	Is the business a Williston Chamber of Commerce partner?
4. Amount Requested	Amount requested is \$1,500 or less.
